The Heart of Colorado FiberArts Guild's ("HCFG") 16th Annual Wearable Art Fashion Show, along with the Brunch and Boutique, will be held at The SteamPlant in Salida from 10:30 am until 3:00 pm on Wednesday, October 17th. Your fiber art pieces may include garments, scarves, handbags, etc.

Garments and completed paperwork are due to Candace or Janey on Oct. 5 at the Guild meeting in Salida. Otherwise, before October 11th contact either Candace Weiss, drollworks@gmail.com (719-539-7184), 105A M&M, Salida; or Janey Redetzke, janeyredetzke@yahoo.com (316-990-3489), 30481 National Forest Dr., Buena Vista between the hours of 10:00am and 5:00pm.

- **You must include a signed Fashion Show Waiver when you deliver your items to Candace or Janey. (Page 3).**
- **EACH PIECE OF FIBER ART ENTERED MUST HAVE A FASHION SHOW APPLICATION & DESCRIPTION FORM COMPLETED (PAGE 4). IT MUST ALSO:**
 - Be juried by the Committee
 - Be in good condition, clean, pressed, odor free, unused and otherwise presentable.
 - Not have been worn previously in Fashion Show.
 - Not be made from a commercially produced kit. If a pattern or instruction has been used in the creation of a piece, credit must be given to the designer/instructor.
- **EACH PIECE FOR SALE AT THE BOUTIQUE:**
 - Must have an attached Guild Boutique price tag. Price/info and sales tags can be printed from the Guild web page at: <http://www.heartofcoloradofiberartsguild.org/> under Events, Fashion Show and then click the link for Documents or you can go directly to "More" than just click on Documents and then either Fashion Show Fiber Art Tags and/or Fashion Show Jewelry Tags.
 - Must be your own design

- Can be made from a pattern which specifically allows reproduction of the piece or was the subject of a class for which the instructor gave permission to use her/his design for production and sale of each piece.
 - All pieces must be complete, in good condition, clean, odor free, pressed, unused and otherwise presentable.
- **HANDCRAFTED FIBER PIECES TO BE SOLD IN THE BOUTIQUE MUST CONTAIN A LABEL THAT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:**
- Fiber or material content
 - Care instructions for dry cleaning, washing, drying, or ironing
 - The fiber content must be permanently attached if garment is to be worn for warmth, such as a coat.

You **MUST** pick up unsold garments on October 17th between 3:00 pm and 4:00 pm. **NOTE:** *If YOU are unavailable for post-show pick up, you **MUST** make arrangements at least by Monday,, October 16 with Candace Weiss drollworks@gmail.com (719-539-7184) to have someone else pick up unsold pieces.*

Any unsold pieces not picked up will become the property of the Guild and will be added to the following June's Stash Sale.

FASHION SHOW WAIVER :

The Fashion Show Committee Chair(s) and other appointed members will serve as the jury for this show. Pieces that do not conform to the above guidelines will not be included in the Fashion Show. In addition, due to time restrictions for the Fashion Show and number of pieces received, all qualifying pieces may not be included in the Fashion Show but you are free to submit them for sale in the Boutique.

The Fashion Show Committee will handle your items with the utmost care. By submitting items for the 2018 Fashion Show, I waive any claim for damage or loss against the Heart of Colorado FiberArts Guild and/or members of the Fashion Show Committee.
