Program Guidelines.

If you are a member of Heart of Colorado Fiber Guild and would like to request a donation to a Qualifying Organization, kindly fill-out this form.

Donations are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis from a limited pool of funds.

The HCFG Board of Directors reserves the right to suspend, amend or terminate this donation program, at any time and without notice.

HCFG does not and will not support organizations engaging in discriminatory or unlawful practices.

To request a donation for a Qualifying Organization,

The request must come from a current, active HCFG member that is in good standing financially, (i.e., has paid their annual dues or other application monies to HCFG).

Donations that do not specifically meet the above criteria may receive a donation by unanimous approval the HCFG Board of Directors.

Definition(s).

“**Heart of Colorado Fiber Guild**” or “**HCFG**” means a Colorado non-profit organization located in Chaffee County, Colorado that is dedicated to fiber related activities.

“**Limit(s)**” means the annual amount, per calendar year, of \$500 USD that HCFG will donate to a Qualifying Organization.

“**Qualifying Organization(s)**” means a fiber related entity or fiber related event sponsored by a Chaffee County organization. Examples include, Salida Fiber Festival or Rock Day, or other such fiber related entities/ events as may occur in Chaffee County.
