Heart of Colorado FiberArts Guild Board Meeting Minutes, June 12, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by guild **President Karen Robinson**. Present were **Carolyn Nelson, Sue Keyes, Sandee Jaastad, Cheryl Eigsti, Judy Curran and Elizabeth Shelby**.

Treasurer's Report: Cheryl reported a bank balance of \$4,086.07. The Stash Sale made \$1,359 total for members. The guild took in \$60 from donations and sales by non-members.

Stash Sale: A few issues came up at the recent Stash Sale that need to be addressed before the next one. Namely, at this point we have different rules for different people who want to sell their items. Non-members don't understand how we mark items, and some collect money themselves so we don't know how much or what was sold. The rules really should be standardized.

Free Table: Elizabeth suggested that members might bring items from their own stashes that they would like to give away and place them on a "free table" at the back of

the meeting area on meeting days. This is done by other organizations and is very successful at recycling usable materials. It will be understood that anything not picked up at the end of the meeting will be taken to Newbees by Sandee, who volunteered. The Board unanimously agreed to try it.

Holiday Party: Our December meeting will be held at the Poncha Springs Town Hall. We will set up tables and bring pot luck lunch dishes. Sandee will organize games and Cheryl decorations. The guild cost will be \$30 for venue rental.

Fashion Show: Judy reported that Arlene and Ruthann are trying to find a caterer. Guest artist will be **Emilia Ponomarev**, whose program is entitled, "From Russia with Felt." Sue finished her knitted centerpieces which will be given away to someone at each table. We can set up Tuesday evening. We will follow last year's schedule of brunch, program, and then boutique.

Scholarships: We have not been successful in attracting scholarship applicants. It was decided that charitable giving within Chaffee County would make more sense in the immediate future. Cheryl moved that the guild give fiber-related items up to a value of \$500 to the Boys and Girls Club. Sandee seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved. The motion was amended to "one year at a time." The Board will take up the question again each year.

Newsletter: Carolyn will request items for inclusion a week before the newsletter goes out. The next newsletter will come out in late August and will contain a reminder of dues needed.

Budget: Cheryl passed out the budget for next year. Sandee moved the Board approve the budget, Judy seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 2.25 p.m.
