YOU AND YOUR FIBER: A COMPILATION FROM STUDIO TO STASH, WITH Janet Yinger

Janet will cover the creative process, knowing your own work environment preferences, how to plan your studio or work space(s), project planning guides, and tracking and labeling your stash. It will be appropriate for all types of fiber aficionados. She has made a large notebook resource that can be brought to meetings for members to consult or “check out”. She has also create various worksheets that can be freely copied to help members with project planning.

P J BERGIN "FELT IN HAND STUDIO" SPRING WORKSHOPS:

HYBRID SCARF (NUNO):

Use the natural materials of wool and silk to make a one-of-a-kind wearable art scarf that will have all your friends raving about how creative you are! Using an un-dyed silk scarf, you will create your masterpiece by layering wool roving on top and then, using the wet-felt method, fuse the fibers together to make a translucent, flowing scarf. Use the skills learned in this class to make your own fabric for wearable art clothing. 4-6 students accepted.

Please bring several old towels, a sack lunch (we'll have only 30 minutes for lunch) and your own drink/water bottle.

Thursday, April 23, 10 am - 3:30 pm at PJ's studio. Cost of workshop: \$90.00 (all materials included).

FELT COASTERS:

Learn the art of layering wool to create colors ("color blending") and textures for artistic and decorative coasters for entertaining. They can also make great hostess gifts! The ancient techniques of the wet felt method will be explored to make the coasters mini-art pieces. 4-6 students accepted.

Please have your lunch before you arrive. Bring several old towels, a light snack and your own water bottle or drink.

Heart of Colorado FiberArts Guild Meeting Minutes, March 6, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by President Candace Weiss. Last month's minutes having been disseminated as an addendum to the newsletter, Nancy noted that the Treasurer's Report should have read "\$3,200" as the guild bank balance, not \$4,000. Diana Smith moved to accept minutes as corrected, Kristi Ketchum seconded, minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Nancy noted the guild has 42 members at this time. The end of January bank statement shows a balance of \$3,200.

Program: Sheryl Campbell set up a sock on her "cranky" sock-knitting machine and explained the process and some history of machine-made socks. She produced a completed sock during the rest of the meeting.

Fiber Festival Booth Committee Report: The committee met after the last guild meeting and decided to have the booth this year. There will be a \$10 fee per person and two hours of work for booth entries plus 15% of each sale. Diana Smith volunteered to coordinate the booth. Kaye and Sandee will produce an informational flyer on the guild for inclusion in sales bags. The group having voted in favor of their decision to continue the booth, the committee will meet again within the next two months. Arlene suggested that an ongoing committee would keep the knowledge pool alive as would a written procedural manual.

Fashion Show and Boutique: Elizabeth Jenkins of New Mexico is confirmed as guild artist. No workshop is confirmed yet. Table favors and centerpiece ideas are needed. Michelle Gapp is again catering the meal. Elizabeth Shelby was asked to coordinate the boutique and agreed. Arlene provided a written list of procedures which will be very helpful.

Programs and Workshops: Arlene reported PJ Bergin will do a couple of workshops this spring and sent around a sign-up sheet. Next month's program will be on organizing of studio space, including tracking of stash and storage, by Janet Yinger. Janet will be program chair next year.

Library: The boxes of guild-owned books are now at Miki Russell's house. Sandee Jaastad moved we sell the books, giving first preference to guild members, and have no library. Karen Robinson seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously passed. It was decided that first the list of books will be sent out to the membership via email by Karen and members will let Sandee know which books they want. She will handle sales to members

until June. Books will be placed for sale at the June stash sale and in the September Fiber Festival booth. Nancy volunteered to pick up the boxes of books from Miki.
